

Obtaining a Kenyan Visa

In the summer of 2015, Kenya changed the application process and visas are no longer able to be purchased at the airport. Chariots has put together some information to help make the application process as easy as possible. Before you start you'll need:

- Passport
- Photo of yourself (a headshot against a neutral background. We've often just taken a photo in the office and emailed it to ourselves)
- A scanned image of your passport bio page
- A scanned or electronic copy of your flight or hotel itinerary
- A credit card for the \$51 visa fee

Log on to : www.ecitizen.go.ke

Click Create an account

Select Create an Account for eVisa Visitors

Follow prompts on screen to create the account

Once the account is created, you will be sent an e-mail verification. Follow the instructions on the email to proceed. It should take you to <https://account.ecitizen.go.ke/login>

In the Dashboard select Make Application

Select Kenyan Visa

Then choose Apply for a Single Entry Visa

And select Apply Now

The majority of the fields on the application you'll need to enter information that pertains specifically to you. We've included some answers below to help answer other questions that are centered around the trip.

****It is very important that the information you submit matches your passport exactly.**

Proposed Date of Entry The date that your flight lands in Kenya

Proposed Date of Departure from Kenya The date that your flight departs from Kenya

Arriving by Air

Select point of entry by air Jomo Kenyatta Airport, Nairobi

Wait 24-48 hours after submitting your application, then your visa should be ready to print. You will not receive an email or notification when your visa has been issued. You have to sign into your account to check the approval status.

Log into www.ecitizen.go.ke

Log in using your email address and the password you set up

Click the button that says "Get Service Now"

Under "Recent Applications" you should see a blue box that says "Issued" and a download button on the right that will allow you to download and print your visa.
